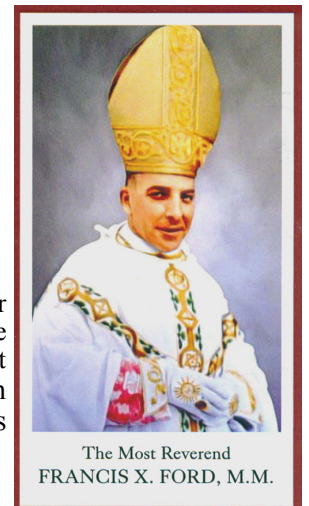
## The Bishop Francis Xavier Ford, M.M. Guild

### **Bishop Francis Xavier Ford, M.M.**

Maryknoll Missioner, Catholic Foreign Mission Society of America  
Born in Brooklyn, New York  
January 11, 1892  
First Seminarian of Maryknoll  
Ordained...December 5, 1917  
Consecrated Bishop...December 5, 1935  
Died in Prison in China...February 21, 1952

Last December 3, 2017, the diocese had a special mass to launch the process of canonization of our own bishop Francis Xavier Ford from Brooklyn who became a missionary in China. To support the cause of his canonization, a guild is being created.
