Sr. Maria Regina will be speaking about Our Lady as the model disciple, and how we, as Catholic women, can learn from her in various passages in the Gospels; how we can become missionary disciples and share this gift with others.



English Workshop Speaker:

She is a consecrated lay-missionary and has served with Corazon Puro, an organization focused on chastity using St. John Paul II's *Theology of the Body*, for the past 8 years.
